- ITS Regional Planning Initiatives
- Multimodal Traveler Information ITS Applications

- Innovations Snow and Ice Management Tools
- · Freight and Logistics Management
- Smart Parking Facilities

Each project or initiative will be judged based upon the following criteria:

- Engineering and Planning Innovation
- Safety Improvement
- Economic Impact
- · Customer Satisfaction
- Environmental Impact Mitigation
- Innovative Partnerships and Stakeholder Involvement

The award will be presented during the ITS WI Transportation Conference on October 19, 2023. The recipient will receive a plaque and the project title will be added to the commemorative display of project awards at the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Wisconsin Traffic Management Center.
